### **New Member Application Instructions**

Thank you for your interest in participating in the Wilmington Farmers' Market at Tidal Creek. Please follow the steps below for completing your New Member Application.

- Read the Official Rules and By-Laws of Wilmington Farmers' Market at Tidal Creek. These documents can be viewed from our website, <u>thewilmingtonfarmersmarket.com</u> under "Become a Vendor".
- Wilmington Farmers' Market at Tidal Creek is an all local, producer-only market. Only applicants that produce their items within 100 miles of Wilmington will be considered.
- 3. Submit your non-refundable \$25.00 application fee via check made payable to <u>Wilmington Farmers' Market</u>. The Application and payment can be mailed to, or dropped off at Tidal Creek Co-op at the following address:

- 4. The Board of Directors will review applications on a monthly basis, paying particular attention to applications that offer unique products and complement the current offerings at the market. Selected applicants will be contacted by the market manager to set up an inspection of your farm or place of business.
- 5. Notification of your application status will be emailed to you when a decision is reached.
- **6.** If accepted, new members are required to pay the Annual Membership Fee before attending the market. <u>Membership options</u>:
  - <u>Full Time Membership</u>: allows attendance for all market days (\$175 annual fee)
  - Part Time Membership: allows 25 or fewer market days attendance (\$125 annual fee)

In addition to the annual fee, a \$25 market fee is collected each time you set up at the market. \*Please keep in mind we are a year-round market and are open every Saturday 8am-1pm throughout the year.
